**Meeting Summary:**

- The NAWAC Pig Subcommittee's first meeting was held on 15 December 2020 in Wellington and on Teams. The purpose of this meeting was to establish and confirm the subcommittees terms of reference, identify knowledge gaps, and discuss the judicial outcomes.
- The subcommittee agreed that the terms of reference, meeting summaries, and relevant papers will be publicly available via website publication.
- The code of welfare drafting group's request to have industry representatives on the subcommittee was reviewed and denied. Consistent communications will be had between the subcommittee and industry experts for information, advice, and expertise across all matters.
- The Lawyer noted that the judgement was explicit that industry and economic influences may be taken into consideration, however, should not outweigh the animal welfare impacts.
- The subcommittee agreed that a five domains assessment should be undertaken and facilitated by an independent expert.
